How do you study the scriptures? Here are two approaches you might find helpful:

Theological Bible Study

As you read the text, consider the following questions:

What does this text say about God?

What does the text say about humanity? (us)

What does the text say about our relationship with God?

S.O.A.P. Method

Scripture selection (read)

Observations about the scripture selection

Application (how does this apply to my life?)

Prayer (focused on what God has revealed to you through the Word)

REGISTRATION NO LONGER REQUIRED


