

Last week, we took 17 people on a youth mission trip to Honduras to serve at Rancho Ebenezer, a home for neglected, abused, and abandoned children.

After a 1,200-mile flight, and a challenging, hour and a half bumpy bus ride, we dedicated ourselves to making a positive impact.

Our youth worked on building fences, installing gutters, painting and helping out in numerous ways. On Thursday, we were able to help a local church family by replacing a dirt floor with a new concrete one in two of the rooms of their home.

We provided tutoring in math, reading, and English, and engaged with the children and staff in spirited soccer matches.
