In the spring of 1988, church members, Jim Brennan, Charlene Erbskorn, Az Flowers, Laura Flowers and Emilee Rush had a desire to form a ministry that would support families in our city and county who were strugaling financially to make ends meet. That desire became In Christ's Name Ministry and Fund. On June 23,1988, the ICN ministry assisted its first family. During that initial year, 117 families received much-needed help. Since that time, the ministry has provided vital support to thousands of families in our community, offering assistance with utilities and food.

ICN does not receive financial support from the church budget. Instead, it operates entirely on donations — many given as memorials and honorariums — allowing us to continue serving those in need.

Each Monday morning, members of the ICN committee meet to interview applicants, carefully assessing each request and verifying the need. Everyone who meets the established criteria receives assistance, ensuring resources go to those who need them most.
